5. New/Continuing Business/Action Item:

5.1 Discuss alternatives for the relocation of the Emeline SSP Exchange Williams presented power point slides of strengths and limitations of fixed site at Emeline Syringe Exchange. A mobile participant survey was conducted between Dec 1st thru Dec 9th to twenty-five unique participants. Commission was concerned that the survey was not capturing the opinion of those not utilizing the exchange. The Commission inquired if the program has investigated what the overhead costs could be to downsize to a smaller site and add a mobile van. Gutierrez confirmed that they have not and prior experience with testing program was costly due to purchase, maintenance, and insurance for van. Gutierrez suggested collaboration with HPHP who already has a van and serve this population. Emily Chung added that leasing spaces is

possible but need to run some comparisons once a directive is given from the Commissioners. Chair Bruder suggested that Commissioners seek out their supervisors from their district to inquire about this directive for a mobile van and bring back more information to the next Commission meeting.
