MHSA Three - Year Plan*

Every three years, entities receiving MHSA funding must submit a plan that details the programs being administered, budget allocations, program updates and/or implementations, population/communities being services as well as links to the most recent outcomes measurements reports.

This plan works to identify persistent mental health service gaps and develop strategies to address them over the next three fiscal years, based on the community needs assessment and stakeholder input.

MHSA Annual Updates

Counties are required to provide community members with an update to the MHSA Three-year plan on an annual basis.

County Board of Supervisors



EXPAND EXISTING OR DEVELOP NEW PROGRAMS:


